Raise awareness of the concerns of modern slavery and provide training for workers to enable them to recognise a cause for concern.

We will ensure staff are fully aware of what to follow if they suspect a case of modern slavery or human trafficking in terms of notifying which relevant authorities and to obtain the appropriate support for the victims.

We ensure that our suppliers have the same ruling of adapting a zero tolerance to Modern slavery and have a policy that would be available to us.
